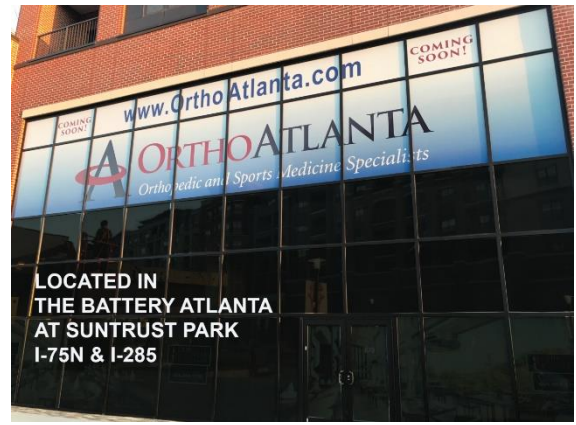

From Cobb Parkway (Hwy 41-West), turn right at Circle 75 Parkway. Make a quick left turn onto Heritage Court SE, and turn into the RED PARKING DECK second entrance. Park on level P4 and take Stairwell B.

Convenient Parking

OrthoAtlanta patients should park in the RED PARKING deck. You may also find it convenient to park in the GREEN PARKING deck.

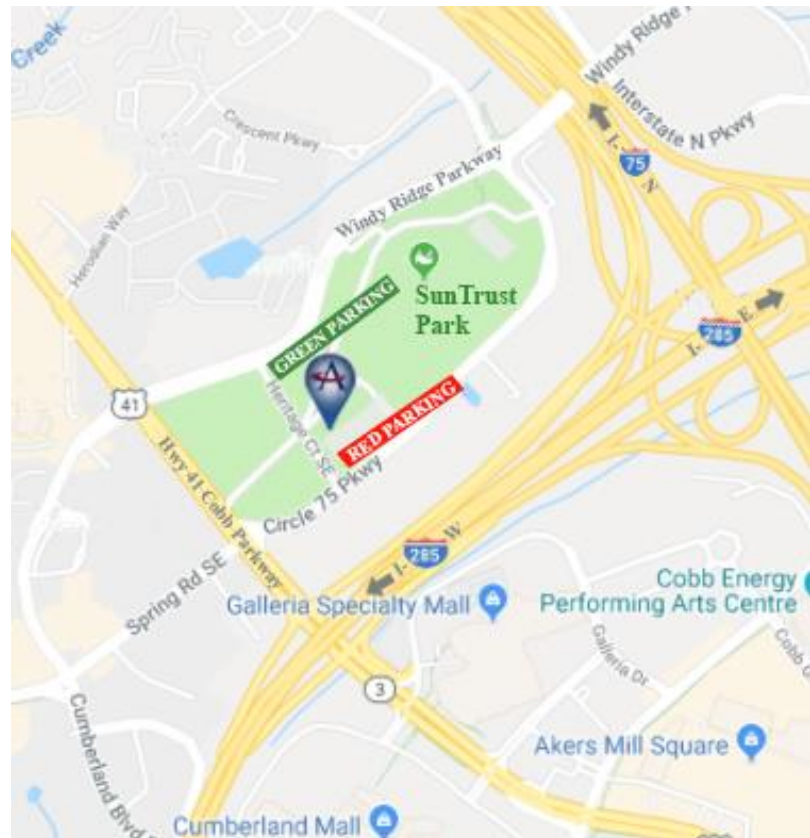
From the RED PARKING deck, park on level P4 and take Stairwell B to the street level, turn left and walk up the sidewalk to the OrthoAtlanta entrance.
